A cross on a heart, resting on the center of the Messianic Rose and surrounded by a circle to symbolize eternity, was adopted by Martin Luther as his own Coat of Arms and as an expression of trust in God. "The Christian's heart is resting on roses even while beneath the cross it reposes."

Reformation day is October 31st.
