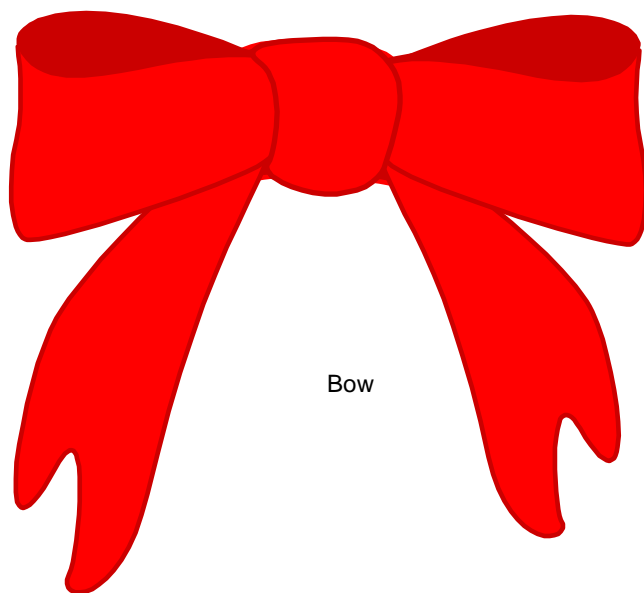


## Wreath Craft – Advent Activity

1. Cut out wreath center with candle, bow, and all the individual holly leaves (24 leaves on sheet).
2. Paste wreath center with candle in the middle of a paper plate or centered on a large sheet of construction paper.
3. Beginning with the large leaves, paste the leaves around the edge of the wreath center, along the edge, overlapping the edge and each other slightly. Alternate dark and light backgrounds. Add the smaller leaves randomly in a new layer, to cover any blank spots.
4. Paste the bow on the wreath, on top of the leaves.

This craft can be used as an advent calendar to count the days until Christmas. On or before December 1, complete steps 1 and 2, then every day following, paste 1 leaf onto the wreath shape until Christmas eve. On December 25, paste the bow onto the completed wreath.

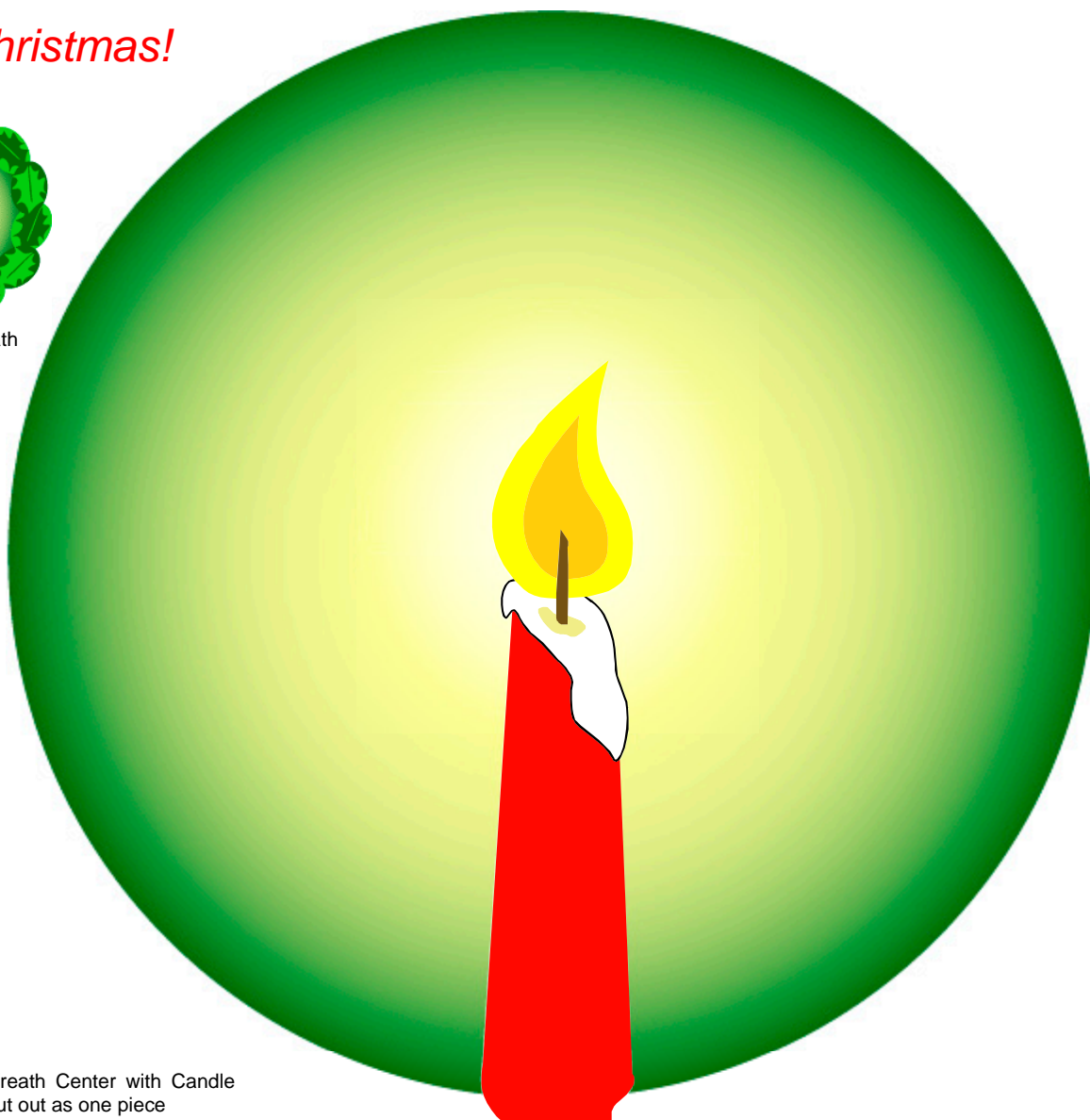

Completed Wreath

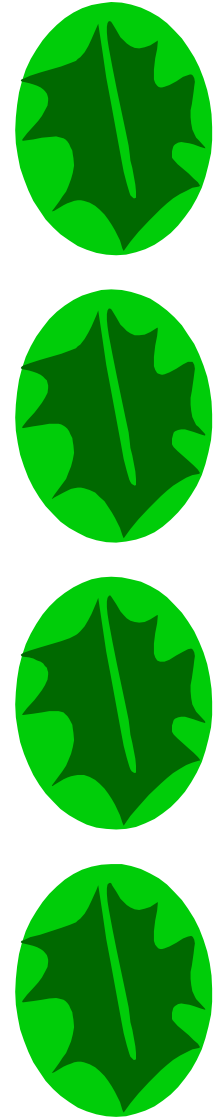
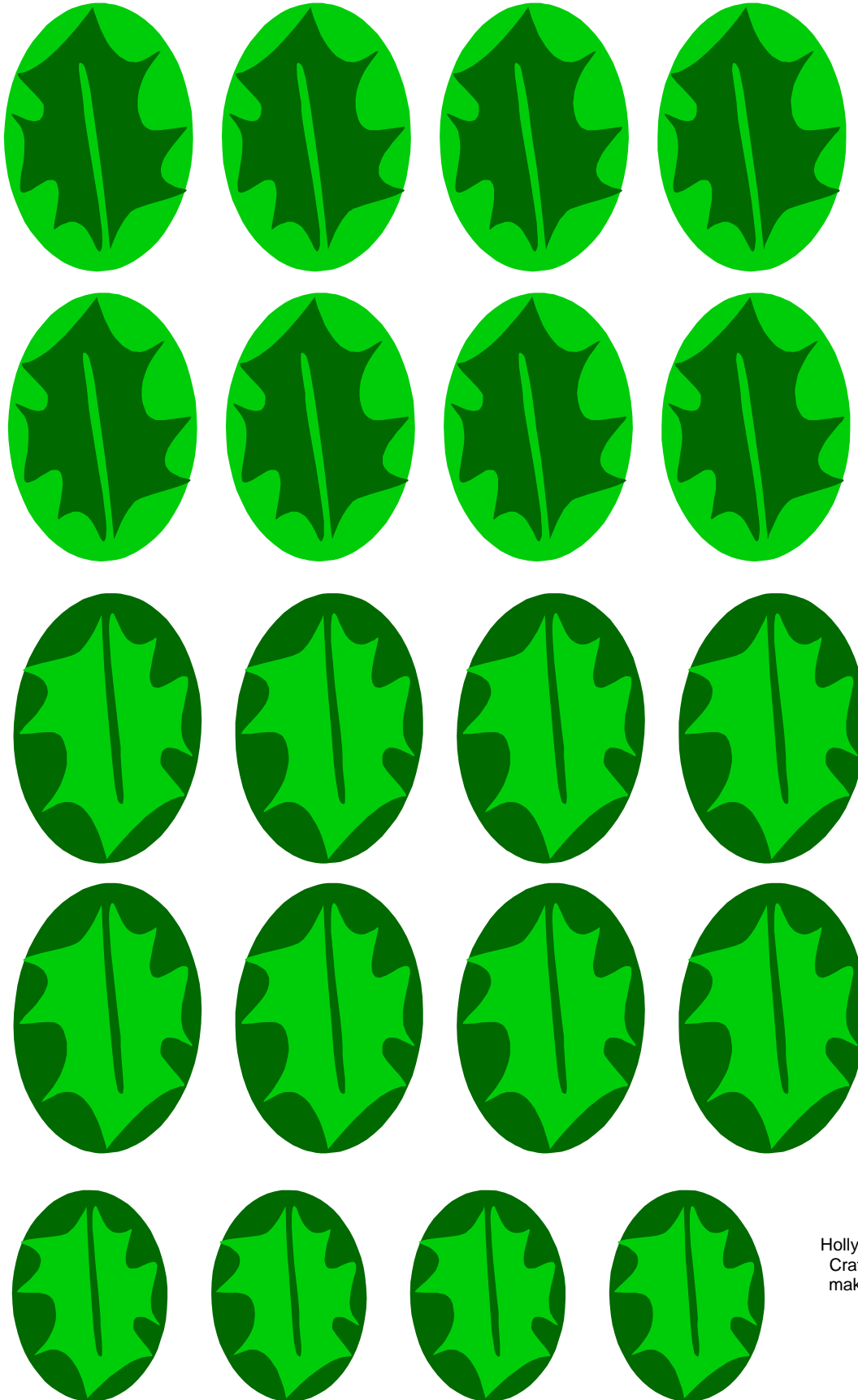


Wreath Center with Candle
